Congratulations on your New Bullmastiff Puppy Purchase.

Shots

Your puppy has received its initial worming and initial shots and has been to the vet 3 times every two weeks for evaluation and check for any health problems with the puppy. Your new puppy will be due again for its next series of shots at 9 weeks and then again at 12 weeks. Due to their young age, it is advisable that new pup be kept away from other pets and to avoid excessive handling especially with strangers, until they have completed their shots. Your pup was wormed at 2 and 4 weeks and again at 6 weeks and a fecal test was done. Due to a young puppies underdeveloped immune system, it is recommended that you continue to have your puppies wormed every few weeks and follow up with additional fecal tests.

Food

Your puppy has been weaned from his mother at the time of purchase and has been fed with Royal Canine Puppy Food for Large Breed Dogs, Our Kennel highly recommends the use of Royal Canin Dog Food and that you keep you dog on the puppy food until 18 months of age. Avoid all table scraps ect. For a minor upset stomach or constipation or diahrrea, a small amount of pumpkin (not the pie mix) can be added to its food for a few meals. If this does not clear it up, take the puppy to the vet.

When arriving home

Your new puppy will take about 5 days to adjust to its new environment and being separated from its litter mates. During those days, he will appear unhappy and will cry often and may even refuse to eat for a day or so. But eventually he will adjust especially when you hold him often and speak to him. Provide him with a warm soft place to sleep where he feels secure.

Potty Training

Your new puppy has not been potty trained at the time of purchase although he has been gaining some experience in using the training pads. It is advisable to begin the potty training as soon as your puppy has adjusted to his new environment. Bullmastiffs are

very intelligent and even though they may have some accidents will soon catch on the correct potty habits.

Registration and Immunization Records

Your new pup will come with its AKC registration papers that you will have to complete and submit to AKC, Your puppy will need to be named for AKC submission. You will also be provided with an immunization record. Any questions regarding their shots and worming can be made to TriCounty Vets in Seymour, Tennessee. We highly recommend puppy classes and that your puppy when older gets enrolled in the Canine Good Citizen Program.

Bathing

During the first 12 weeks, only bath puppies with either puppy wipes or a warm wash cloth. Do not get them entirely wet and make sure they are dried very well. Bullmastiffs skin can dry out easily so avoid excessive washing.

Guarantee

We guarantee that our pups are healthy at the time they leave our premises. A physical examination by your vet within 5 days from date of purchase is highly recommended. If you pet is mildly sick and it has been determined that is was the fault of the seller, please forward recommended treatment plan and estimate to us before authorizing treatment for our review and we will discuss with you either a partial refund on the puppy or payment on our behalf for its treatment. If the puppy was not examined within 5 days of purchase and has not followed the recommended immunization schedule, this portion of the guarantee is voided. If it is determined that your puppy has a genetic disorder that would severely limit its quality of life, we will gladly refund your money or provide you with another puppy if available. Full documentation must be substantiated by both your veterinarian and ours.
