Thank you for purchasing your puppy through Kampbellkennels Bullmastiffs!! All of our puppies have been raised in our home and have been well socialized. This socialization is very important to continue throughout the lifetime of your bullmastiff. At the time of purchase the puppy has been wormed and been

provided its initial shots and have been vet checked. A shot record is provided at the time of sale. All puppies are guaranteed for 2 years against any major genetic defects. If a defect is determined, documentation must be sent to the breeder. If it is something that can be repaired and buyer wishes to keep the puppy, the breeder will pay half the cost of the vet bill, up to half the purchase price. If buyer does not wish to keep the puppy or the defect can not be fixed, buyer can surrender the dog to the breeder and the buyer will receive a replacement puppy from our kennels. The buyers agrees to provide monthly heart worm protection, flea and tick prevention and to keep the dog up to date on all of its boosters and yearly vet exams must be conducted. Full records must be maintained. Failure to do so, will void the guarantee. Buyer must also feed the puppy a high quality dog food and provide adequate housing and exercise. Dogs are not permitted to be tied up or left outside without proper shelter. The breeder has the right to do home visits on any pups to make sure they are being taken care of, and if there are any signs of abuse, breeder has the right to remove the dog or puppy from the premises. Breeder also has the right to request health records.

All puppies must be taken to a vet within 5 days from the date of purchase for a physical examination to determine that the puppy is in good health. If it is determined that the puppy is in ill health due to the fault of the seller, buyer must provide written documentation within 5 days and the seller will either replace the puppy or pay half the vet bill.

The purchased dog may not be used in fighting, sold at a pet store or dropped off at a shelter. If the buyer is no longer able to provide a home for their bullmastiff, we must be contacted so that we have the first opportunity to regain possession of the dog. Once the breeder has had the first right of refusal, buyer may sell or give away the bullmastiff to new owners of their choosing as long as the breeders have the name and contact information of the new owners. If a male puppy is purchased with full registration and the buyer decides at a later date to

have the puppy fixed, the breeder must be notified so we have the opportunity to collect any sperm at the breeders expense before the dog is fixed.

Buyers must agree to provide the bullmastiff with a good home, good quality dog food, yearly exams and follow the AKC guidelines for vaccinations and worming and proper socialization (Puppy classes and Canine Good Citizen classes are highly recommended) Puppies must also have k Campbellkennels within their registered name. There are no stipulations on their call name.

The breeder must be notified in writing of all breedings and their outcomes for those who have purchased a puppy with full registration. Information to be provided is date of whelping, number of puppies, color and marking and any genetic defects or health concerns with the pups.

K Campbellkennels is more than happy to hold your puppy while you make arrangements to come pick it up. For all puppies purchased under 8 weeks of age, we will hold and care for the puppies until they reach 12 weeks of age. All puppies not picked up by 12 weeks will incur a 25.00 a week boarding fee to cover feeding and the buyer is responsible for half the vet bills incurred during this time period. For puppies purchased after 8 weeks of age, Campbellkennels will hold puppies for 3 weeks so the buyer can make arrangements for pick up, after that time boarding charges will incur. For those with special circumstances, boarding charges may be waived.
